

When the flag is to be flown at half-staff

For flags that can't be lowered, such as those on many homes, these are three options: (1) BLACK STREAMER, (2) BLACK BOW or (3) HORIZONTAL

1. The Black Streamer from the top of the flag is an acceptable alternative. The ribbon should be the same width as a stripe on the flag and the same length as the flag.

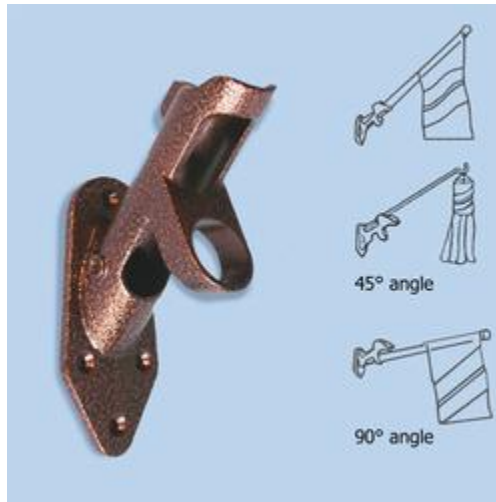


2. The Black Bow from the top of the flag is also an acceptable alternative.

3. You can also display just the Flag in a Horizontal position, as in the third position below (90° angle), from this type of wall bracket:



ADDITIONAL INFO

For a wall-mounted flag, three black mourning bows should be attached to the top edge of the flag, one at each corner and one in the center.

- On Memorial Day fly your flag at half-staff until noon, then raise it back to the top.

- Fly your flag at half-staff on Peace Officers Memorial Day, unless it is also Armed Forces Day. (Peace Officers Memorial Day honors federal, state and local officers killed or disabled in the line of duty.)

- The President can order that the flag be flown half-staff at any time and for any duration of time.

***It is also appropriate to fly your flag at half-staff on:**

- Patriot Day (September 11)

- Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day (December 7)
